The upgrade is another step in the constant upgrade of the telecommunications infrastructure that has been done in the past - from the manually connected calls by an operator, to party lines, to single family lines. Now it is the ever increasing Internet speed that the younger generations look to.

The signing of the The Telus Next Generation Fibre Network Agreement is the first step and will enable a Telus fibre team member to do a walk through and present a proposal on how the upgrade would be done. After the proposal, your co-op will be able to make an informed decision on the Telus PureFibre upgrade.

There is no guarantee that Telus will continue to pay all of the costs so it is important that your co-op look into the matter. The co-op does not want to bear the cost in the future or lose members because it cannot compete with the services provided by other housing providers. Also, there is no obligation to sign up now or in the future. This will ensure your co-op is future-enabled for when you are ready.
