

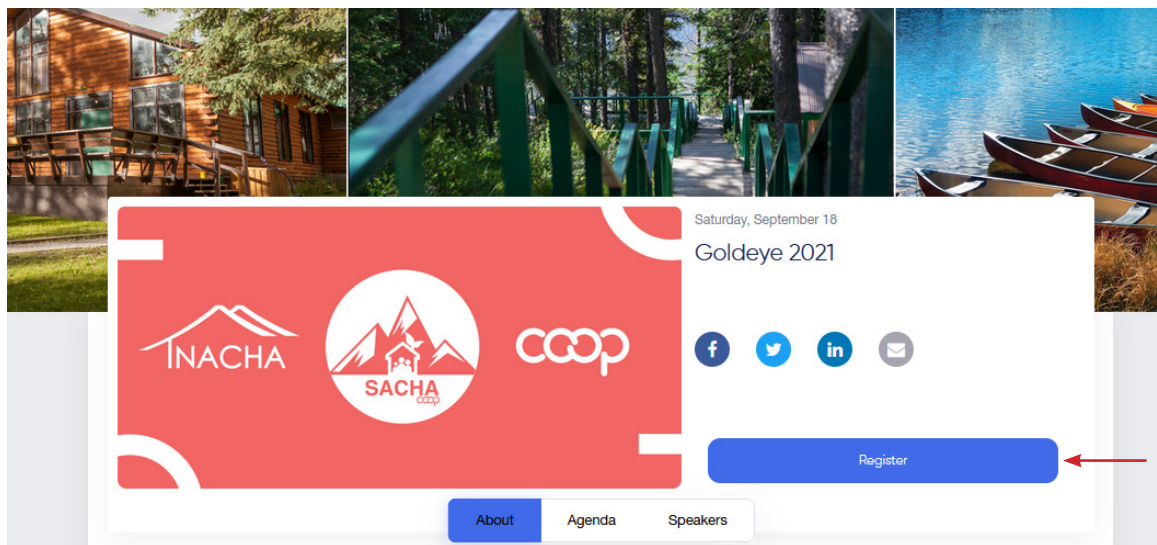
HOW TO REGISTER

NACHA/SACHA 2021 VIRTUAL GOLDEYE CONFERENCE

1. Open the event page on your browser (see below link).

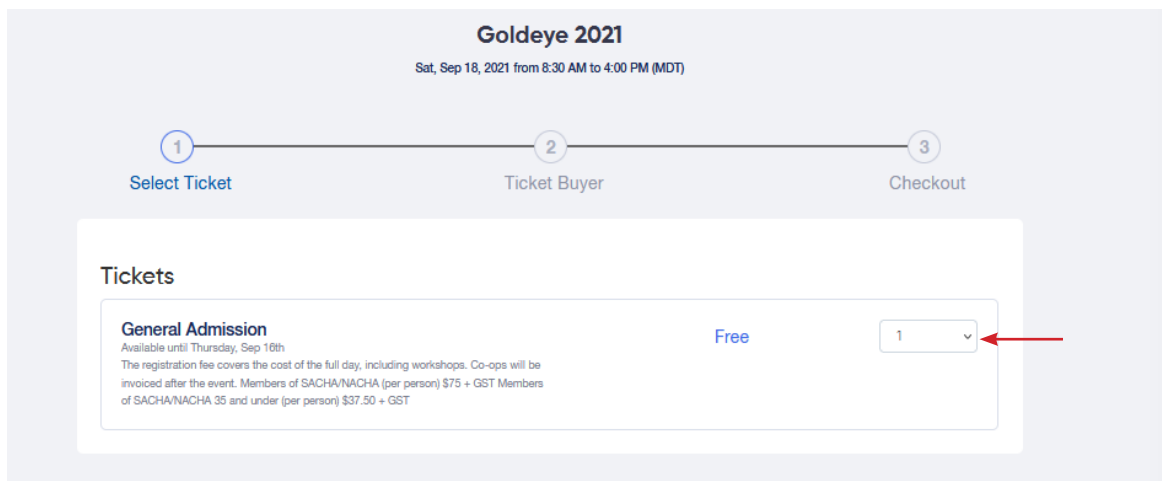

2. Click the **Register** Button



3. Select the number of registrants.

Please only register yourself (select 1 ticket only). While the site allows you to register more than one person, this can cause significant registration issues later on. If you need to register more than one person, please email info@nacha.ca or admin.sacha@shaw.ca to request the proper procedures.



4. Click the **Continue** button which will appear after you have selected the number of registrants.

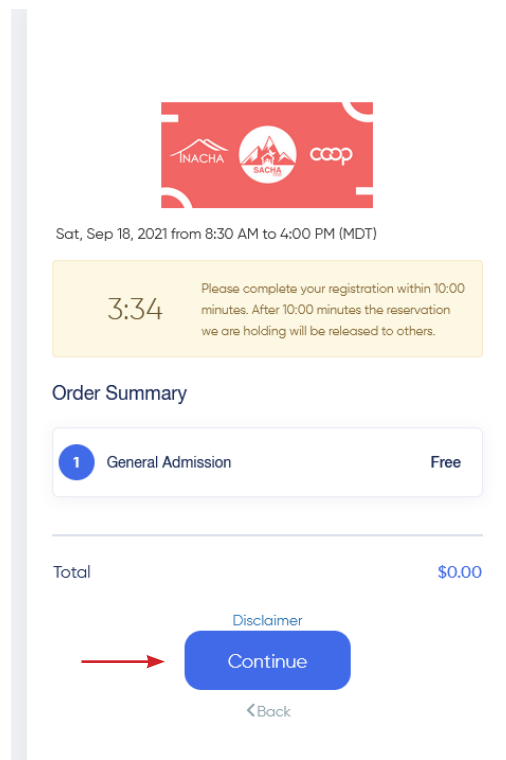

Once you have filled in the information, please review it to ensure that it is accurate and click **Continue**. Please ensure that you write the password down and keep it simple.

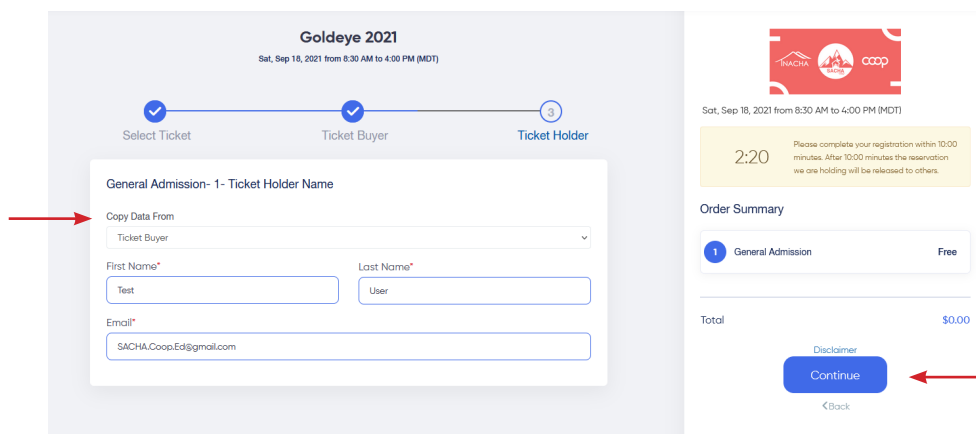

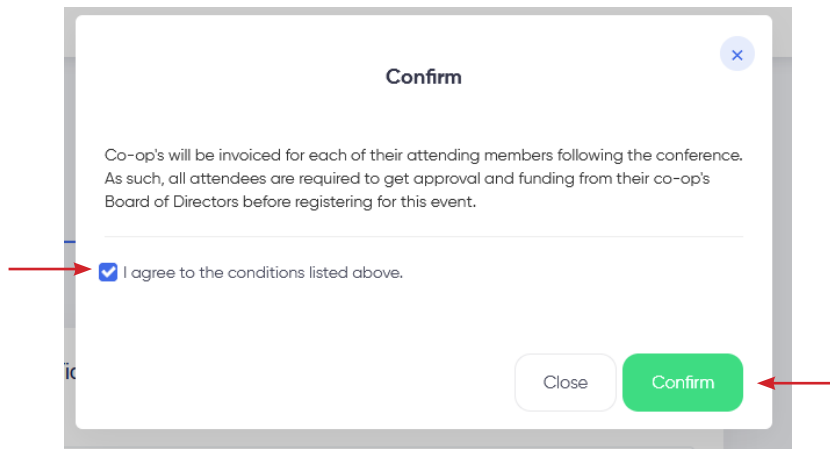
- Click **Continue** once the information has been reviewed.

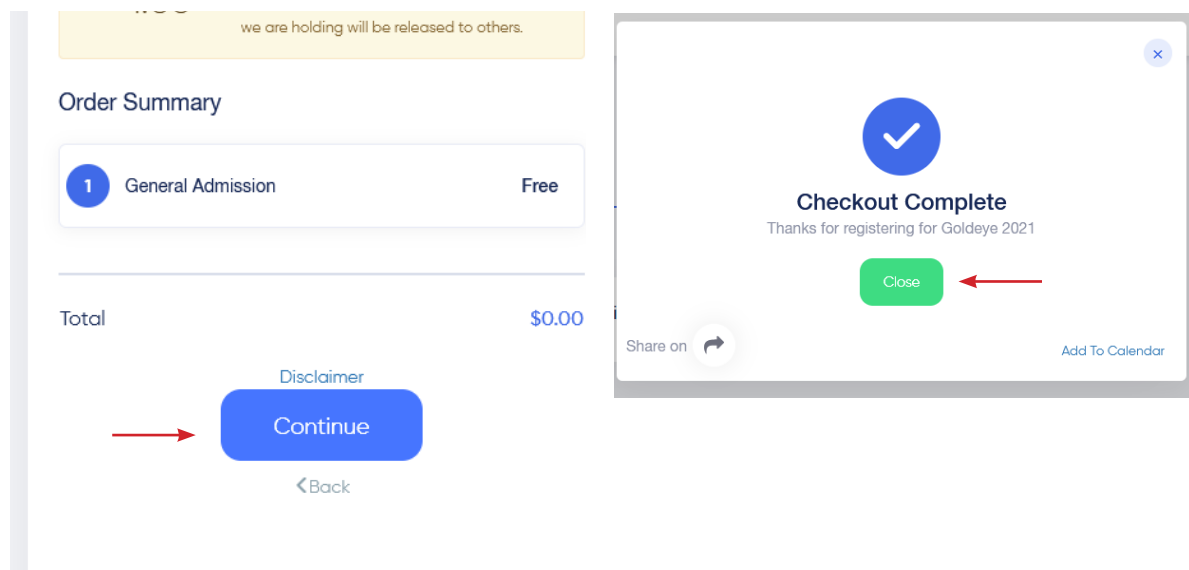
Once the information has been entered, click **Continue**.





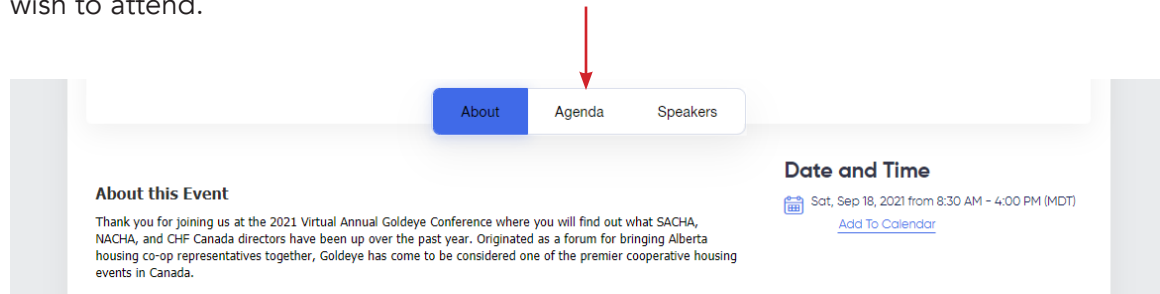

9. Click **Close** to go back to the main page.



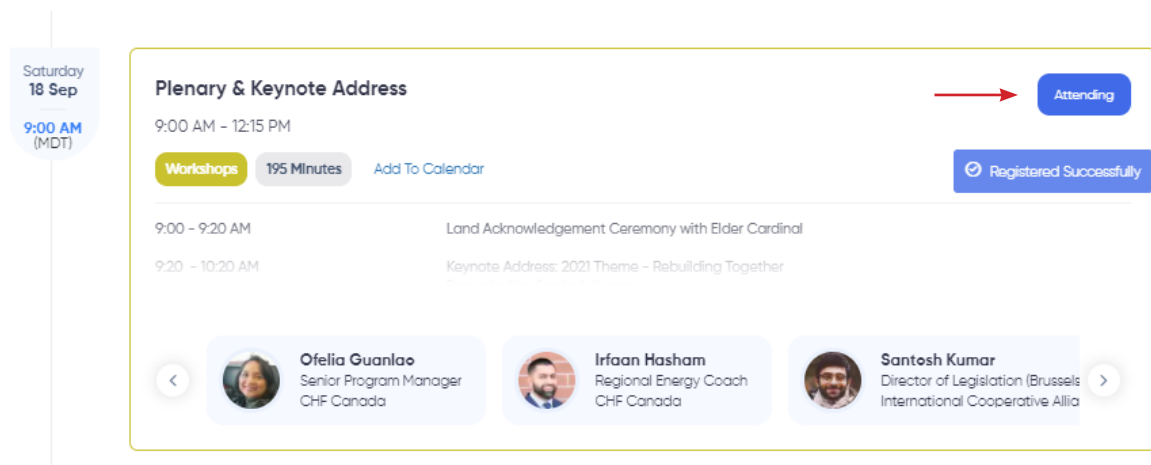
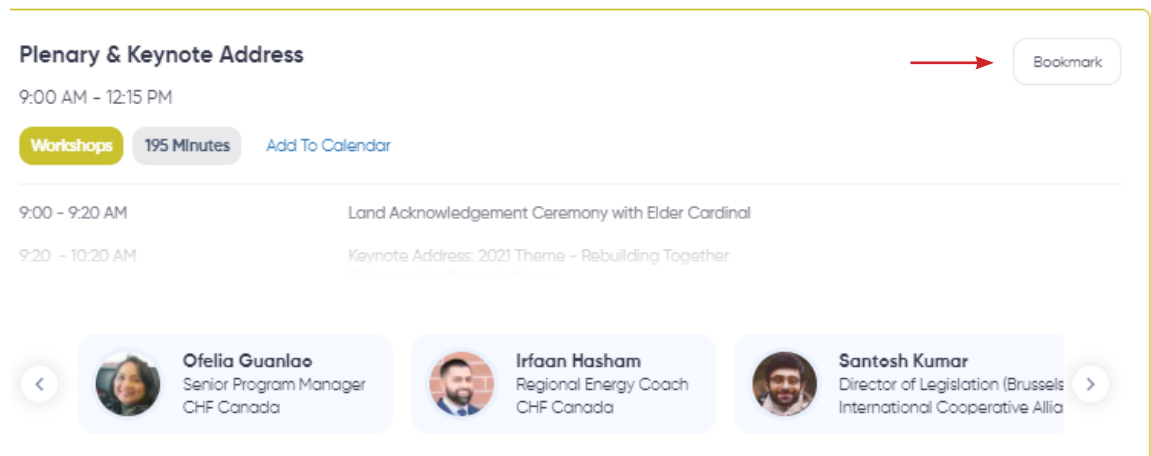
10. Click **Agenda**.

11. Click **Bookmark** on all of the sessions that you plan to attend.

Once you have done that, your Bookmark button will change from white to blue and will state **Attending**. Also, please ensure that you register for Welcome & Housekeeping.



12. Once you have registered for all of the sessions that you plan to attend you can click on **My Sessions** to ensure that you have registered for all of the sessions you intended. If you need to make any adjustments, click **Sessions** and follow Step 11.
